

Qualifications for Offices*

U.S. Representative

- At least 25 years of age; Citizen of U.S. for 7 years; and Resident of Missouri

General Requirements for All State and County Offices

- Not delinquent in payment of state income taxes, personal property taxes, real property taxes on the place of residence as stated on declaration of candidacy
- Not been found guilty or pled guilty to a felony or misdemeanor under the federal laws of the U.S. or Missouri
- No a past or present corporate officer of any fee office that owes taxes to the state
- Specific office requirements follow below

State Auditor

- At least 30 years of age; Citizen of the U.S. for 15 years; and Resident of MO for 10 years before the election

State Senator

- At least 30 years of age; Qualified MO voter for 3 years before the election; and Resident of the district which he is chosen to represent for 1 year before election

State Representative

- At least 24 years of age; Qualified MO voter for 2 years before the election; Resident of the district which he is chose to represent for 1 year before the election

Circuit Court Judge

- At least 30 years of age; Citizen of the U.S. for at least 10 years; Qualified MO voter for at least 3 years before the election; Resident of circuit for at least 1 year; Licensed to practice law in MO

Associate Circuit Judge

- At least 25 years of age; Qualified MO voter; Resident of the county for at least 1 year prior to the election; Licensed to practice law in MO

General Qualification for County Offices

- Citizen of the U. S.; Resident of the state 1 year before the election; Registered voter in MO
- Specific office requirements follow below

Presiding County Commissioner

- Resident of the county

Clerk of the Circuit Clerk

- Over 21 years of age; Resident of the county 3 months before the election

County Clerk

- Over 21 years of age; Resident of the county 1 year before the election

Recorder of Deeds

- Over 21 years of age; Registered voter; Resident of MO and county for 1 year before the election

County Treasurer

- At least 21 years of age; Resident of county for at least 1 year before the election; meets statutory bond requirements for the office

Prosecuting Attorney

- At least 21 years of age; Licensed to practice law in MO; and Resident of the county for 1 year before the election

County Auditor

- Over 21 years of age; Resident of the county for 3 months before the election; Familiar with the theory and practice of accounting by education, training and experience

Collector of Revenue

- Resident of the county; Meets the statutory bond requirements for the office
